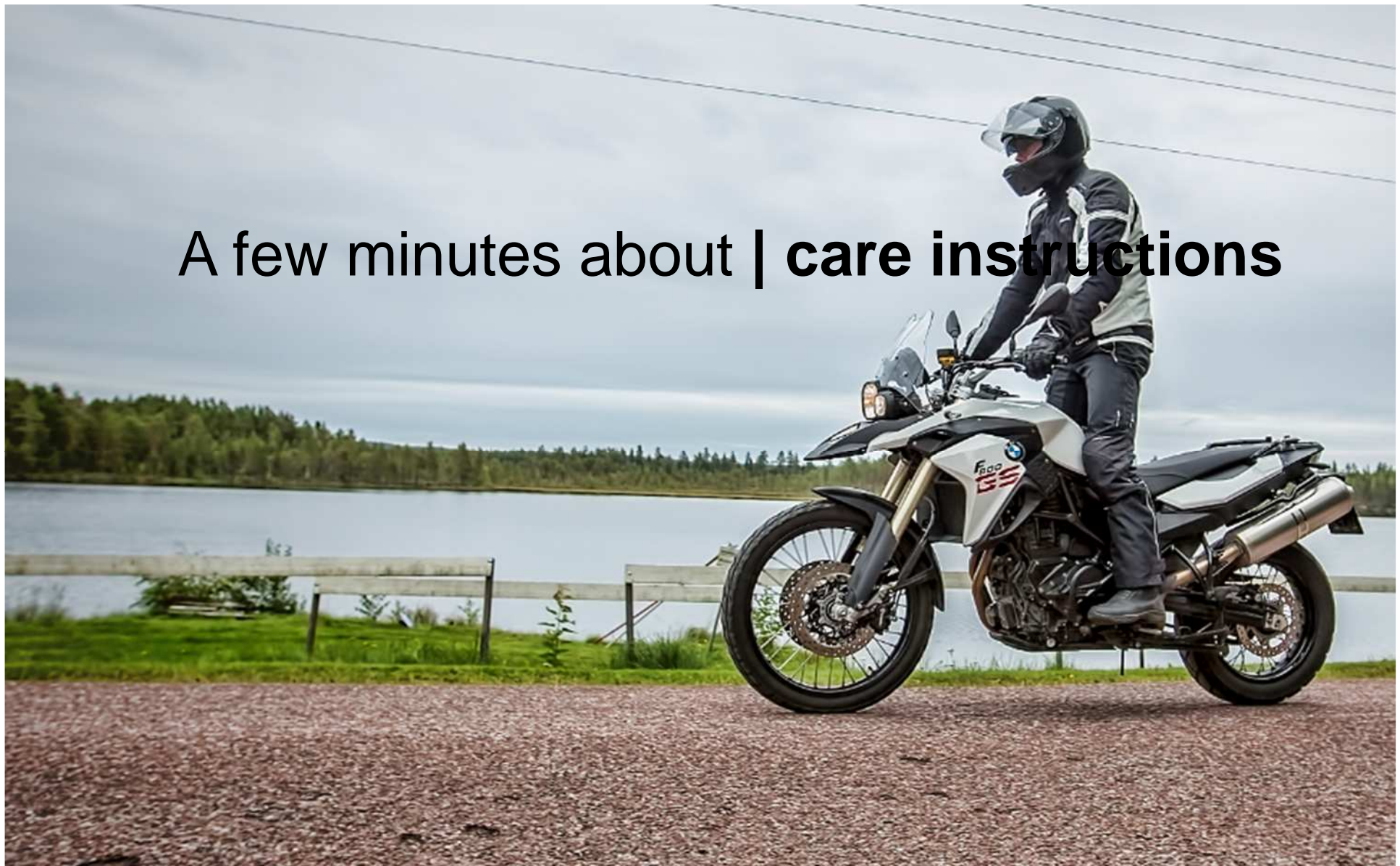

Why cleaning?

- Dirt attracts moisture which reduces comfort and performance.
- Smell...could be negatively perceived by the surroundings.

What to think about when cleaning our textile clothes

- Water temperature.
- Remove protectors.
- Dry the clothes on a gallow hanger.
- Do not use softener when washing!

Why re-impregnation of our textile clothes?

Most products are treated with a water resistant impregnation. This treatment can be worn or washed off allowing water to stick to the material.

The impregnation helps repel dirt which can then be easily brushed off.

Moisture in the outer material reduces the membranes breathability function because moisture naturally moves towards dry climates.

An impregnated product dries quicker.

Wet clothes are cold clothes!!

Moisture dissipates heat more than 20 times faster than air.

**If you remain dry you will not
become cold!**

Why treatment of leather materials?

The surfaces is easier to clean by just brushing off dirt.

The leather dries faster and remains soft and flexible.

The seam thread will last longer.

Think about

- Use cleaning products especially made for leather or use water and soap!
- Some materials are more sensitive than others. Try cleaning less exposed areas first.
